


# HARVARD CAPS HARRIS POLL



Field Dates: March 20-21, 2024



## SURVEY METHOD

This survey was conducted online within the United States from **March 20-21 among 2,111 registered voters** by The Harris Poll and HarrisX.

Results were weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online.






## U.S. Economy: Right Track / Wrong Track



M2. In general, do you think the American economy is on the right track or is it off on the wrong track?


# PERCEPTION OF THE U.S. ECONOMY ALSO SLIGHTLY UP, WITH 44% SAYING IT IS STRONG TODAY




















































Is Joe Biden mentally fit to serve as President of the United States or do you have doubts about his fitness for office?
























































































