ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

Accomplishments Under Chairwoman McDaniel's Leadership

- Firing Nancy Pelosi, expanding the Senate Majority in 2018, winning Michigan for Trump in 2016, turning out 4 million more Republicans than Democrats in 2022, flipping 15 congressional seats in 2020, investing \$4 million into the VA gubernatorial election in 2021, and electing more Republican women to Congress than ever before.
- Creating a permanent Election Integrity Department, the RNC has been the most litigious under her leadership. Currently, we're filed in 78 election lawsuits in 23 states, with more to come. We have had election integrity and legal counsel in battleground states for multiple cycles under her leadership.
- Launching Bank Your Vote – the Republican Party's first of its kind nationwide campaign focused on educating, engaging, and empowering Republicans to vote early and/or by absentee, even embracing ballot harvesting where legal.
 - Not only is Bank Your Vote active in all 56 states and territories, but websites are also available in 16 languages.
- Sanctioned presidential primary debates for the 2024 presidential election, and a Jewish organization (Republican Jewish Coalition) partnered to host a presidential primary debate for the very first time for either party.
- Since 2017, the RNC has hauled in over \$1.5 billion, bringing over 2.5 million new donors into the Party.
 - Last midterms, there were 2.9 million unique donor contributions, which is the most contributions given in a midterm election year in RNC history.
- The RNC's e-mail house file grew from 3 million subscribers to over 50 million.
 - We also created a texting house file, which did not exist prior to 2017, and is now the highest grossing net revenue channel online.
- Helped launch WinRed to bring Republicans a competitive edge to ActBlue.
 - A sign that the RNC debate criteria strengthened the GOP (i.e. unique contributors), 88% of new donors to WinRed this year came from presidential campaigns.
- State-of-the-art [data and voter score technology \[washingtontimes.com\]](#) powered by the RNC shared with every Republican candidate free of charge.
 - The RNC provides a multi-function app to deliver organizational, fundraising and political tools, in both English and [Spanish. \[thehill.com\]](#)
- In 2022, the RNC invested to grow our party with 38 brick-and-mortar [community centers \[prod-static.gop.com\]](#) in 19 states to make [inroads \[thehill.com\]](#) with [Hispanic \[washingtonexaminer.com\]](#), [APA \[usatoday.com\]](#), and [Black](#) voters.
 - Hispanic and Asian support for the GOP jumped 10 and 17 points respectively, and Black voters shifting 4 points to the right.
 - We had the best midterm performance ever with Hispanics, and in Florida, Republicans won a majority of the Hispanic vote.
 - Our community centers worked to deliver historic wins for diverse candidates including Monica De La Cruz, Michelle Steel, Juan Ciscomani, Anna Paulina Luna, Jen Kiggans, and Tony Gonzales.
 - Currently, the RNC has 7 community centers in battleground states and districts across the country.
- Strategic, long-term advances to the RNC also include cutting ties with the biased Commission on Presidential Debates, taking on Big Tech and suing Google, strengthening our Party's partnerships with our sister committees, selecting our 2024 RNC Convention city and working ahead to select the host city for 2028.

2024 Investments

- The RNC has hired Political and Election Integrity Directors and support staff in 15 battleground states, including important House and Senate states such as New York, California, and Montana.
- The RNC’s political team focuses on a data-driven ground game to grow our party through voter registration efforts and minority outreach, as well as to turn out Republican voters through door knocks, phone calls, and volunteer recruitment.
 - These are strategic investments in not only presidential, but House and Senate target states, and why the RNC has also invested in community centers in states like [California](#), [New York](#), and [Texas](#).
 - The RNC has also rolled out the Bank Your Vote ([BankYourVote.com](#)) Initiative – an early in-person voting and ballot harvesting push to improve Republicans’ vote totals heading into Election Day. Currently, the RNC has Bank Your Vote websites for [56 states and territories and in 16 languages](#).
 - The Bank Your Vote websites will not only inform voters, but also help them request a ballot online or by mail, register to vote, check their registration, find their early voting location, or even find their polling place on Election Day. As the election year progresses, additional features will be added, and these tools will be enabled on each site to empower voters to bank their vote.
- This comes as the RNC establishes a full-time Election Integrity Department this cycle as a permanent part of the RNC’s infrastructure.
 - The 2022 midterm cycle was the RNC’s first opportunity to build an election integrity program due to a recently lifted Consent Decree brought by Democrats which prohibited our participation in election integrity activities.
 - The program was unprecedented in both scale and success, effectively completing a transition away from pop-up-shop style election operation to year-round infrastructure with tens of thousands of poll watchers and poll workers and dozens of key litigation wins.
 - We will continue to file key lawsuits, hire in-state election integrity directors and counsels in our target states, and continue to recruit and train tens of thousands of poll watchers and poll workers.
 - Currently, the RNC is engaged in 78 Election Integrity lawsuits in 23 states across the country. *[For more information on some of our lawsuits, [click here](#)]*
 - We file proactive lawsuits to hold Democrats accountable for passing illegal guidelines and ignoring the law.
 - We also file defensive lawsuits to protect good laws from dark-money Democrat attacks.
 - [Last week](#), a New York Appellate Court ruled in favor of the RNC’s lawsuit against a local law that would allow 900,000 non-citizens to vote in New York City. This affirms an earlier court victory on the same issue in [September 2022](#).
 - We’re currently engaged in litigation to protect election laws from DOJ lawsuits in Georgia, Arizona, and Texas.
 - We successfully defended Florida’s SB 90 in the Eleventh Circuit and the state’s wet signature requirement in district court.
 - The department will continue to evolve and refine itself, specifically in areas like stakeholder management and developing new technology to more effectively streamline the poll-watcher recruitment and shifting process.
